DECLARATION

Jasmine Auriculatum Absolute (India) is a natural botanical extract obtained by solvent extraction of the flowers of *Jasminum auriculatum*.

The material has been evaluated with reference to the International Fragrance Association (IFRA) Standards, 51st Amendment.

As a natural absolute, compliance is determined by the concentration of naturally occurring restricted constituents such as benzyl alcohol, benzyl benzoate, benzyl salicylate, linalool, eugenol (trace), farnesol and other naturally occurring fragrance constituents. The complete fragrance formulation and the applicable IFRA Product Category must always be assessed.

CONDITIONS OF COMPLIANCE

- Batch-specific GC/MS verification where appropriate.
- Toxicological assessment of the finished fragrance.
- Compliance with the latest IFRA Standards.
