IFRA STATUS

Makiang Absolute is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS).

No individual IFRA Standard has been published specifically for Makiang Absolute (*Syzygium nervosum*).

Accordingly, compliance is determined by:

- Naturally occurring restricted constituents.
 - Batch-specific analytical composition.
 - Concentration in the finished fragrance.
 - Contributions from other fragrance ingredients.
 - Intended IFRA product category.
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REPRESENTATIVE RESTRICTED CONSTITUENTS

Current published analytical literature does not establish a consistent profile of IFRA-restricted constituents for Makiang Absolute.



AROMOLOGY

Any naturally occurring restricted constituents must be evaluated using batch-specific GC-MS analysis.

IFRA COMPLIANCE

No universal maximum use concentration can be assigned from currently available technical data.

Compliance with the IFRA Standards requires:

- Review of the batch-specific GC-MS profile.
- Review of naturally occurring restricted constituents.
- Calculation within the complete fragrance formulation.
- Application of the appropriate IFRA product category.

CERTIFICATION

Makiang Absolute 20% (Vietnam) may be used in fragrance formulations provided that:

- The finished fragrance complies with the IFRA Standards (51st Amendment).
- Any naturally occurring restricted constituents are calculated.
- Batch-specific manufacturer documentation is available.

CONCLUSION

No universal IFRA Category limits are declared for Makiang Absolute 20% (Vietnam).

Compliance must be established using batch-specific analytical data and the complete fragrance formulation.

The manufacturer's current IFRA documentation shall always take precedence.
