IFRA Status

Makrut Lime Leaf Oil is a Natural Complex Substance (NCS) whose composition varies naturally. It contains naturally occurring constituents such as citronellal, citronellol, linalool and limonene that are individually addressed by IFRA specifications and finished-product safety assessment.

Commercial suppliers may issue batch-specific IFRA certificates with maximum use levels calculated from their analytical profile. One published supplier certificate specifies maximum concentrations for IFRA Categories based on its own batch analysis (for example, Category 4: 0.70%, Category 2: 0.23%, Category 3: 0.04%). These limits are supplier- and batch-specific and should not be applied universally.

3. Include contributions from all fragrance ingredients.



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4. Apply the relevant IFRA category.
5. Complete the finished-product safety assessment.
