Declaration

Mate Absolute is a Natural Complex Substance obtained from *Ilex paraguariensis*. The supplied product contains approximately 50% Mate Absolute and 50% ethanol.

Based on the information available, Mate Absolute under CAS No. 68916-96-1 is not identified as having a specific standalone IFRA maximum-use Standard under the 51st Amendment.

This does not mean that the material may automatically be used without limitation. Natural Complex Substances can contain constituents that are individually prohibited, restricted or subject to specification requirements under the IFRA Standards.

IFRA explains that its Standards are intended primarily for fragrance ingredients used in fragrance mixtures incorporated into finished consumer products. A Certificate of Conformity is a supplier declaration and does not replace a complete safety assessment.

3. Restricted constituents contributed by this material and all other fragrance ingredients are calculated cumulatively.
4. The finished fragrance mixture is assessed for its intended IFRA product category.
5. Applicable national and regional laws are also observed.

Important Notes

- Ethanol is used as a diluent and does not remove the need to assess the Mate Absolute portion.
- This certificate applies only to the product identified above.
- It does not certify the safety of a finished cosmetic or consumer product.

- A batch-specific GC/MS or supplier compositional statement should be used where exact IFRA calculations are required.
- The IFRA Standards are a voluntary global risk-management framework and remain separate from legally binding cosmetic regulations.
