Methyl Salicylate Natural – Minty is a fragrance raw material consisting principally of methyl salicylate, CAS No. 119-36-8.

IFRA maintains a searchable Standards Library covering fragrance-material prohibitions, restrictions and specifications. The 51st Amendment was formally notified in July 2023.

This certificate confirms that the material may be used in fragrance formulations only when:

- Its concentration complies with all applicable IFRA Standards.
- The complete fragrance formula is assessed for the intended IFRA category.
- Contributions of methyl salicylate from every fragrance raw material are calculated cumulatively.
- The resulting finished consumer product complies with applicable legislation.

ADDITIONAL LEGAL RESTRICTIONS

European cosmetic legislation independently restricts methyl salicylate according to the type of finished cosmetic product. These legal limits are separate from IFRA certification and must also be observed.

The EU regulation also states that methyl salicylate must not be used in preparations intended for children under six years of age, except toothpaste, within the conditions specified in the regulation.

CONDITIONS OF CONFORMITY



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This certificate is valid only where:

- The supplied material meets its stated specification.
- The material is used solely as a professional fragrance ingredient.
- The applicable IFRA category maximum is not exceeded.
- The finished fragrance is assessed by a qualified safety assessor.
- Regional cosmetic and consumer-product laws are followed.
- Use in products intended for children is separately reviewed.
- The user maintains appropriate formulation and traceability records.

CONCLUSION

Methyl Salicylate Natural – Minty may be used as a fragrance ingredient under the IFRA 51st Amendment, provided that the applicable category restriction, cumulative methyl salicylate exposure and all relevant legal limits are observed.
