Givaudan states that the oil is obtained by steam distillation of the flowering tops followed by freezing to partially remove menthol, while retaining approximately 50% menthol for its characteristic minty freshness.

IFRA Compliance Statement

Mint Arvensis Oil is a natural essential oil covered by the IFRA Standards.

The oil is not subject to a dedicated ingredient-specific IFRA Standard. However, compliance with IFRA depends upon:

- Naturally occurring restricted constituents
- The concentration of the oil within the fragrance

- The intended IFRA product category
- The complete finished fragrance formulation

The material should therefore be evaluated as part of the finished fragrance safety assessment.

Naturally Occurring Restricted Constituents

Typical constituents include:

- Menthol
- Menthone
- Isomenthone
- Menthyl Acetate
- Limonene
- Linalool
- 1,8-Cineole
- Pinene Isomers

These occur naturally and vary with harvest, origin and production batch.

Maximum Use Levels

No ingredient-specific concentration limits are assigned to the neat Mint Arvensis Oil under the IFRA 51st Amendment.

Finished fragrance compliance shall be established after considering:

- Naturally occurring restricted constituents
 - All other fragrance ingredients
 - Applicable IFRA product category
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Declaration

Based upon currently available IFRA Standards:

- Mint Arvensis Oil – Dementholised complies with the IFRA Standards (51st Amendment).
 - No ingredient-specific concentration restriction applies to the neat essential oil.
 - Compliance must be verified using the complete fragrance formulation.
 - Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) should be followed.
