IMPORTANT DECLARATION

Oakmoss Green Absolute cannot presently be certified as conforming to the IFRA 51st Amendment Oakmoss Extract Standard.

The designation “Green” refers to the commercial colour and olfactive profile. It does not demonstrate that the material has been purified to meet the IFRA compositional requirements.

IFRA’s 51st Amendment was formally notified on 30 June 2023, and the IFRA Standards Library remains the authoritative source for the individual ingredient Standards.

MANDATORY RAW-MATERIAL SPECIFICATION



AROM OLOGY

For an oakmoss extract to qualify for use under the applicable IFRA Standard, the following conditions must be satisfied:

Overall Raw-Material Conformity	All requirements must be met	Not established

The IFRA guidance requires Natural Complex Substances to be assessed both against the Standard for the complete extract and against any Standards applicable to their restricted constituents.

IFRA CATEGORY LIMITS

The following limits apply only to oakmoss extract that first satisfies the mandatory IFRA compositional specification.

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NON-APPLICABILITY OF CATEGORY LIMITS

The category limits above cannot be issued as authorised use levels for this grade until batch-specific testing confirms compliance with the mandatory raw-material specification.

Until such evidence is available:

- The material must not be represented as IFRA compliant.
- No IFRA Certificate of Conformity should be issued.
- The listed limits must be treated as regulatory reference values only.
- Dilution of a non-conforming extract does not convert it into an IFRA-conforming oakmoss raw material.
- Finished-product use must be assessed by a qualified fragrance safety professional.

COMBINATION WITH TREEMOSS

Where compliant oakmoss and treemoss extracts are both present in a fragrance formulation, the total contribution of the two materials must remain within the applicable category maximum.

The addition of treemoss extract directly to oakmoss extract is not permitted under the oakmoss specification.

CATEGORIES 1 AND 6

For Categories 1 and 6, ingredients must also satisfy applicable requirements for materials used in products where incidental oral exposure may occur.

CONDITIONS REQUIRED FOR FUTURE CONFORMITY

An IFRA conformity statement may only be issued after obtaining batch-specific evidence confirming:

1. Atranol below 100 ppm.
2. Chloroatranol below 100 ppm.
3. Dehydroabietic acid not exceeding 0.1%.
4. No added treemoss extract.
5. Accurate identification of the finished-product category.
6. Compliance with every other applicable IFRA Standard in the complete fragrance formula.



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7. Compliance with applicable national legislation.
