Synarome publicly lists Oudharome among its specialty fragrance materials. Independent historical industry reporting on a Synarome presentation also describes Oudharome as an unusual oud specialty with a noticeable orris-like character.

IFRA 51 Status

Oudharome is a proprietary fragrance mixture.

Its IFRA status therefore cannot be determined reliably from the trade name alone.

Compliance depends on:

- The complete quantitative Synarome formula
- Every IFRA-restricted ingredient present
- Restricted constituents contributed by natural materials



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- The concentration of Oudharome in the fragrance compound
- The fragrance dosage in the finished consumer product
- The applicable IFRA finished-product category
- Contributions of the same restricted substances from all other fragrance ingredients

No unsupported numerical IFRA limit is assigned in this declaration.

Potential IFRA-Relevant Constituents

Because Oudharome is a proprietary oud base, regulatory review may potentially involve materials from classes such as:

- Woody aroma chemicals
- Amber materials
- Leather materials
- Animalic materials
- Musk materials
- Phenolic materials
- Mossy materials
- Natural complex substances
- Balsamic materials



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- Restricted aldehydes or phenols
- Sensitising fragrance ingredients

The presence of any substance in this list is not confirmed merely by the odour profile.

Only Synarome's current regulatory documentation can establish the actual composition.

Natural Oud Distinction

Oudharome must not automatically be represented as:

Natural Agarwood Oil

or

Aquilaria Essential Oil / Extract

Oudharome is a fragrance reconstruction / specialty base intended to provide an oud effect.

Therefore:

- Natural agarwood composition must not be attributed automatically.
- Natural agarwood CAS numbers should not be assigned to Oudharome.
- Natural oud regulatory data should not be copied onto this Synarome base.

Finished Fragrance Compliance

Before issuing an IFRA certificate for a fragrance containing Oudharome, the responsible formulator should:

1. Confirm the product as Synarome Oudharome Product Code 601720.
2. Obtain the current Synarome IFRA 51 certificate.
3. Select the correct finished-product IFRA category.
4. Determine the percentage of Oudharome in the fragrance concentrate.
5. Determine the percentage of fragrance concentrate in the finished consumer product.
6. Identify all IFRA-restricted constituents in Oudharome.
7. Add contributions from all other fragrance ingredients.
8. Apply the lowest applicable restriction.
9. Complete the finished-product safety assessment.
10. Retain the current manufacturer certificate and calculation records.

Fine Fragrance

Perfume, Eau de Parfum, Eau de Toilette, Cologne and similar hydroalcoholic skin fragrances generally fall under:

IFRA Category 4



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The current Synarome Category 4 limit for Product Code 601720 should therefore be used when assessing fine-fragrance applications.

No numerical Category 4 maximum is declared here without the original Synarome certificate.

Declaration

Based on the available product information:

- Product: Oudharome
- Manufacturer: Synarome
- Product Code: 601720
- Product Type: Proprietary oud fragrance base
- Chemical Nature: Mixture
- CAS Number: No single CAS assigned
- Oudharome is distinct from natural agarwood oil.
- A publicly verifiable manufacturer IFRA 51 category table for Product Code 601720 was not located.
- No unsupported category-specific maximum use levels are therefore stated.
- The current original Synarome IFRA Certificate must take precedence for formal regulatory/customer submissions.
- Final IFRA compliance depends on the complete formulation and intended consumer-product category.
