Synarome describes Piperonyl Acetate as a pleasant floral material combining lilac and lily-of-the-valley with cherry and strawberry facets on a powdery and honeyed background.

Synarome places Piperonyl Acetate in its regulatory category:

 - The complete fragrance formulation
 - Correct IFRA finished-product category
 - Finished-product fragrance concentration
 - Product-specific toxicological considerations
 - Applicable cosmetic and consumer-product legislation
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Finished Product Assessment



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For a finished fragrance containing Piperonyl Acetate:

1. Confirm the material as Synarome Ref. 000233.
2. Verify the supplied batch specification.
3. Select the correct IFRA finished-product category.
4. Review the complete fragrance formula.
5. Calculate all other IFRA-restricted substances.
6. Complete the finished-product safety assessment.
7. Retain current manufacturer regulatory documentation.

Important Identification Note

Piperonyl Acetate is specifically listed in the IFRA Fragrance Ingredient Glossary as a fragrance ingredient with a fruity/raspberry descriptor.

It should not be confused with:

- Piperonal / Heliotropine
- Piperonyl Acetone
- Piperonyl Alcohol
- Other piperonyl derivatives

These are separate substances with their own regulatory profiles.
