SCOPE OF CERTIFICATE

This certificate assesses Premium Patchouli EO Light with reference to the IFRA Standards up to and including the 51st Amendment.

The material is a Natural Complex Substance. Its chemical composition may vary naturally between batches and may contain individual constituents subject to specific IFRA Standards.

IFRA STATUS

Patchouli Essential Oil is not generally prohibited under the IFRA Standards.

No universal maximum use level can be certified for every batch of this natural light-grade oil without:

- Batch-specific GC/MS data;
- Confirmation of any IFRA-restricted constituents;
- The intended IFRA end-use category; and



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- The contribution of the same constituents from all other ingredients in the finished formulation.

The contribution of the same constituent from every other fragrance ingredient must be added.

DECLARATION

Based on the representative information available:

1. Premium Patchouli EO Light – Musky is not known to be prohibited under the IFRA Standards, 51st Amendment.
2. The material is a Natural Complex Substance and may contain batch-dependent restricted constituents.
3. The applicable maximum use level must be determined from the original producer's batch-specific IFRA certificate and analytical data.
4. Final compliance depends on the intended IFRA category and complete fragrance formula.
5. The most restrictive applicable constituent limit shall govern the finished formulation.
6. This certificate does not certify any finished perfume, cosmetic or household product.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FINISHED-PRODUCT MANUFACTURER
