IFRA STATUS

Premium Rose Absolute (Turkey) is a Natural Complex Substance.

Its composition varies naturally according to harvest, extraction and geographical origin and contains naturally occurring constituents that may themselves be subject to IFRA restrictions.

Accordingly:

- Batch-specific GC/MS data are required.
- Batch-specific IFRA documentation from the original producer should be consulted.
- Final compliance depends on the IFRA product category and total restricted constituent content.

No universal maximum use concentration is assigned within this certificate.

Methyl eugenol is the principal constituent generally driving IFRA restrictions for natural Rose Absolute.

IFRA CATEGORY ASSESSMENT

For Categories 1–12:

Batch-specific IFRA assessment required.

Maximum permitted concentrations depend upon:

- batch composition;
 - methyl eugenol content;
 - intended IFRA category;
 - concentration of Rose Absolute in the finished fragrance; and
 - contribution of the same restricted constituents from all other ingredients.

COMPLIANCE CALCULATION

Restricted constituent in finished product (%) =

Rose Absolute concentration (%) × constituent concentration (%) ÷ 100

Contributions from every other fragrance raw material shall be included.

DECLARATION

1. Premium Rose Absolute (Turkey) is not prohibited under the IFRA Standards.
2. It is classified as a Natural Complex Substance.
3. Batch-specific analytical documentation is required before assigning maximum use levels.
4. The original producer's IFRA Certificate and GC/MS shall take precedence.
5. Final compliance is the responsibility of the finished fragrance manufacturer.
6. This certificate applies only to the raw material identified above.
