Aromology Trading LLC declares that Rosemary Essential Oil may be used as a fragrance ingredient in accordance with the requirements of the IFRA Standards, 51st Amendment, subject to assessment of its complete composition and the intended finished-product category.

This natural essential oil may contribute constituents that are subject to individual IFRA Standards or other safety considerations. These may include, depending on the batch and chemotype:

- Camphor
- Limonene
- Linalool
- Eugenol
- Citral components
- Other naturally occurring terpenes and oxidation products

No universal maximum use level can be assigned to the raw material solely from its botanical name or CAS number. The permitted concentration in a finished product must be calculated from:

1. Batch-specific compositional or GC-MS data
2. The concentration of each IFRA-restricted constituent
3. Contributions of the same constituents from other formulation materials
4. The applicable IFRA finished-product category

IFRA confirms that Certificates of Conformity are supplier declarations and do not replace a complete safety assessment of the finished product.

Conditions of Certification
