SCOPE OF THE IFRA STANDARD

Vetiveryl Acetate falls within the scope of the IFRA Standard for Acetylated Vetiver Oil.

CATEGORY 1 AND CATEGORY 6 REQUIREMENTS

Because Categories 1 and 6 may involve the ingestion of small quantities of fragrance ingredients, the material must:

- Comply with the applicable IFRA maximum level; and
- Be recognised as safe as a flavouring ingredient under the IOFI Code of Practice where flavour use is intended.

An IFRA certificate alone does not authorise use in oral-care, lip or food products.

CONTRIBUTIONS FROM OTHER SOURCES

No additional contributions from other sources are normally required beyond trace concentrations, according to the applicable IFRA Standard.

However, contributions from other acetylated vetiver materials in the complete fragrance formula must be included when determining the final concentration.
