Thyme Absolute is obtained by solvent extraction of the flowering aerial parts of *Thymus vulgaris* L. and is supplied as a natural perfumery raw material intended for incorporation into fragrance compounds.

According to the IFRA Standards (51st Amendment), Thyme Absolute is not specifically prohibited as an individual fragrance ingredient. However, due to the presence of naturally occurring phenolic constituents such as Thymol and Carvacrol, the finished fragrance must comply with the applicable IFRA Product Category limits and all relevant regulatory requirements.
