Cedarwood Texas Essential Oil is obtained by steam distillation of the wood of *Juniperus mexicana*. It possesses a powerful dry woody aroma with smoky, pencil-cedar and balsamic nuances and is highly valued in perfumery as a natural fixative and woody base note. The oil is particularly rich in cedrol and thujopsene, providing excellent substantivity and stability in woody, fougère, chypre and oriental fragrances.

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
