SECTION 4: FIRST-AID MEASURES

Inhalation

Move to fresh air. Seek medical advice if respiratory irritation persists.

Skin Contact

Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing.

Eye Contact

Flush cautiously with water for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Ingestion

Rinse mouth. Do **not** induce vomiting unless instructed by medical personnel.
